INNOVATION ACTOR OF THE MONTH



The CNRS (French National Center for Scientific Research) is the largest fundamental research organization in Europe. It carries out research in all fields of knowledge.

CNRS has developed **interdisciplinary programs** which bring together various CNRS departments as well as other research institutions and industry.

The CNRS has a **3.4 billion Euros budget** and employs 33,600 people within 1200 research units located throughout France. In 2009, the CNRS signed 1,600 contracts with industry, had a total of 3,765 patent families generating a revenue of 58,2 million euros in royalties. Between 1999 and 2009, 503 companies have been created out of CNRS.

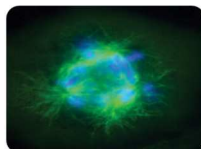

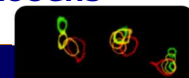
INTERVIEW: Isaac Kohlberg - Harvard Office of Technology Development

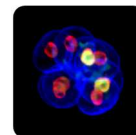
